Bradley Enfield was born in 1995 as a 3rd generation Enfield; his grandfather, Leon Enfield, a charter member in the Jousting Hall of Fame. With a father who spent countless hours training several professional level tournament horses, Brad was shown how to be competitive at a very young age. He made his first ride down the track at just 5 years old with his dad, Bob, leading the horse. As he watched his family members earn multiple State and National titles at the professional level, Brad was eager to follow suit. The Knight of Little Antietam, stemming from the creek running near his family home, moved through the ranks rather quickly with his first title win coming at 10 years old. Over the years, Brad went on to collect several State and National championships across the Novice, Amateur, and the Semi-Pro levels. In 2010, the Knight of Little Antietam won the MD State Semi-Pro Championship, officially moving him into the Professional class at just 15 years old.

Since then, Brad has gone on to follow in the footsteps of the Enfield name, buying and training his own horse, Chex. The Knight of Little Antietam has now won 6 out of the last 7 National Championships from 2016-2022 and 3 MD State titles.

Dedicated to the history filled sport of Jousting, Brad has served on the WMJC and MJTA board, while helping prepare tournaments, exhibitions and demonstrations all across the state.
