Harry Tucker Eubank started jousting in 1919 and actively rode in tournaments until 1970 when he was forced to retire because of failing eyesight. During his long tenure, he rarely missed a tournament and he won many competitions. Several notable accomplishments during his career consisted of wins at the Lynchburg Fair in 1920, Buena Vista, Virginia in 1921 and 1922, as well as the Amherst County Fair in 1921.

He served as president and vice president of the Amherst County Jousting Association and has been a supporter and participant of jousting for over fifty years.
