Mr. Charles Brady was associated with jousting for over thirty years. He served on the committee that founded the Maryland Jousting Tournament Association. Mr. Brady was the Maryland State Champion in the late 1930's and won the St. Stephen's Joust several times. He also won the Marshall Hall Joust several times. Both of these tournaments were considered during those years to be the Championship events in Maryland.

Mr. Brady was a jousting supporter from his earliest days. In his prime, there was no better rider. He traveled many miles to ride for trophies – not money as is the custom today. Mr. Brady was a credit to the sport of jousting.
